Holy Family University Art Gallery Presents “All the Remnants” *Works on Paper by artist Jennifer D. Anderson*

Philadelphia (January 15, 2014) – Holy Family University is pleased to present a unique work of art titled “All the Remnants,” by artist Jennifer D. Anderson. The exhibit will run from February 4th through February 26th, 2014, and will include an artist reception and gallery talk with the artist on February 11th from 6:00pm until 8:00pm. “All the Remnants” is open to public and admission is free.

“All the Remnants” is extremely intricate, created by carefully cutting patterns out of hundreds of exacto blades. These patterns transformed into new images from art history creating lacy delicate remainders of paper and color. Hung away from the wall, a passage of light is able to shine through the image, creating an outlet of interpretation. After viewing this work of art, visitors will have a new outlook on their perception, understanding of memory, and visual language.

Anderson’s work has been exhibited in venues across the United States, abroad, as well as in publications as diverse as *Tricycle* and *The Carolina Quarterly*. Recent exhibitions of her work include the (e)merge art fair and solo exhibitions at Bradley University and Whittier College. In addition to her studio practice, Anderson is an educator. Currently, she is working at Hollins University in Roanoke, VA, as an associate professor of studio art.

Holy Family University Art Gallery is located on the Lower Level of the Education and Technology Center (ETC Building) on the University’s Northeast Philadelphia campus at 9801 Frankford Avenue. The Gallery is open Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 8:00 pm.
